

Coming soon: Pwint Thit Sa 2019 Launch

The 2019 Pwint Thit Sa Report will be launched end April. MCRB and the Centre's pro bono partner, Yever benchmarked around 250 Myanmar companies, against a total of 142 criteria, 80% of them drawn from the ASEAN Corporate Governance scorecard. This year, in addition to "disclosure criteria", there are more "performance criteria", to stretch leading Myanmar companies.
