UK Disability Movement

- ▶ UK disability movement: efforts resulted in establishing complementary policy measures as well as public awareness of the need for equal rights for people with disabilities and about various barriers in society.

Disability Discrimination Act & Disability Rights Commission

- ▶ Finally major achievements with the establishment of the Disability Rights Commissions and Disability Discrimination Act.
- ▶ These measures gave meaning to quotas and levies, enabling more people with disabilities to go out and work and with income to spend.

UK's Withdrawal of the Quota System

- ▶ With systems in place and conditions met in the removal of visible and invisible barriers and all entities working together, and legislation outlawing discrimination, etc., the quota system lost their main position and was withdrawn.

Quotas & Levies

- ▶ Need for Quota to be supported by complementary measures

Particular Needs of Disabled Ethnic Minority People

- ▶ Particular culturally sensitive support measures initiated and necessary for people with disabilities from ethnic minority communities to secure equal opportunities.
