Appendix: Stakeholders interviewed in field research

The interview guidance covered five overarching stakeholder groups and interviews were held one-to-one, in small groups and through focus group discussions:

- Community members;
- Mining workers;
- Companies;
- Government; and
- Actors involved in artisanal/subsistence mining.

A total of 1378 individuals were interviewed, either independently or as part of a semi-structured group discussion during the field research. A diverse range of different stakeholder groups were consulted in each location, comprising 487 individual interviews and 140 focus group discussions.

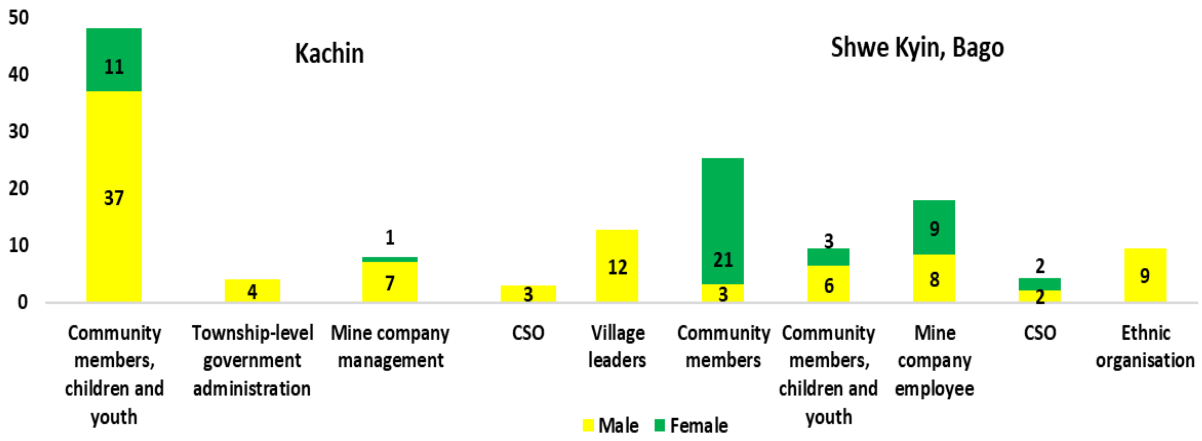

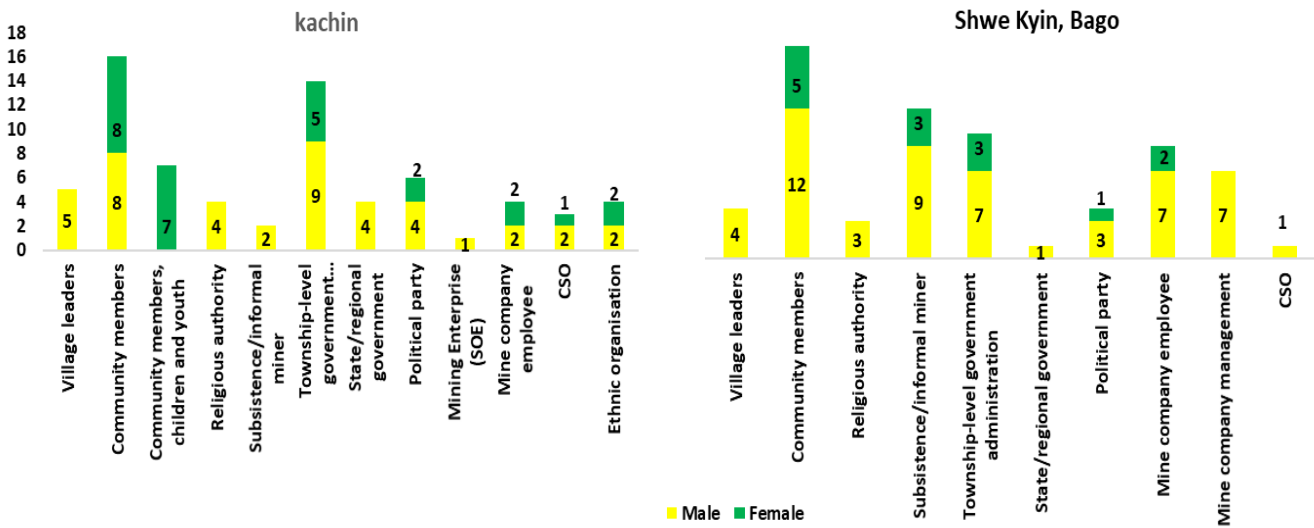

Focus Group Discussions

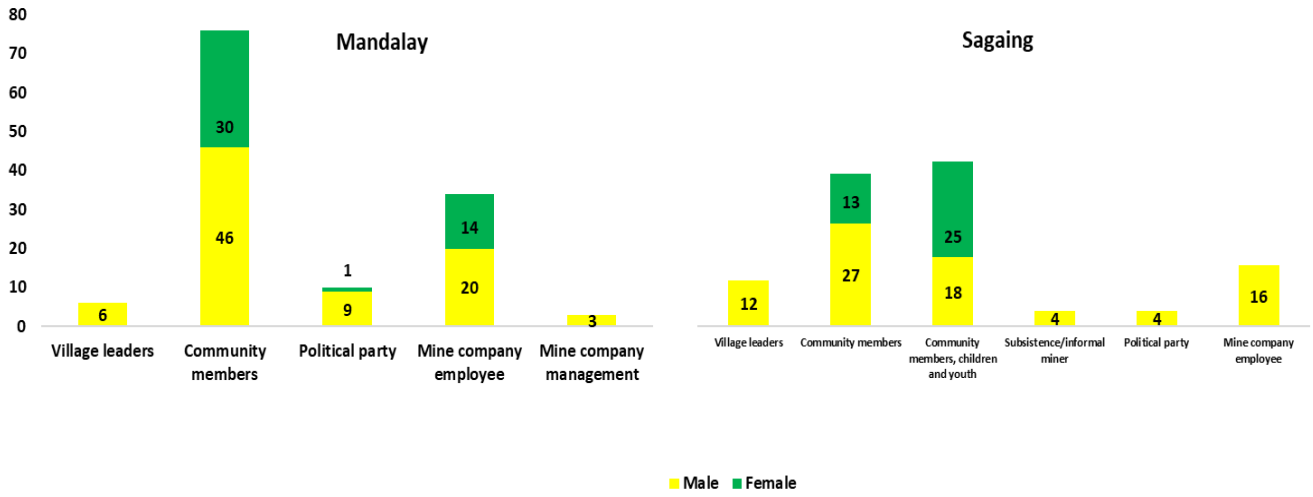


Key Informant Interviews

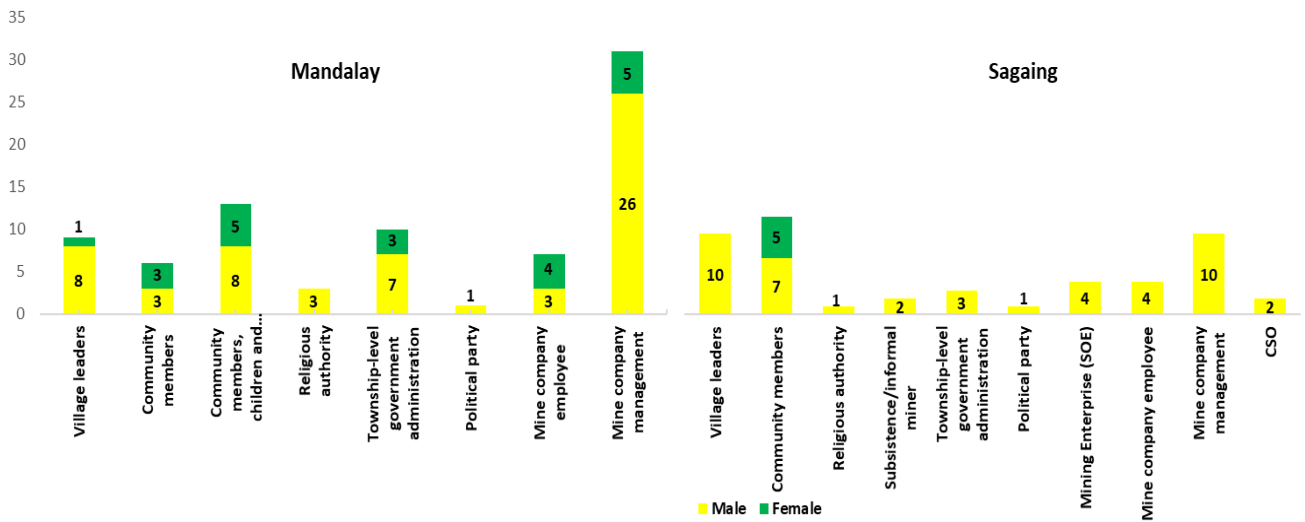


SMALL-SCALE GOLD MINING

Focus Group Discussions

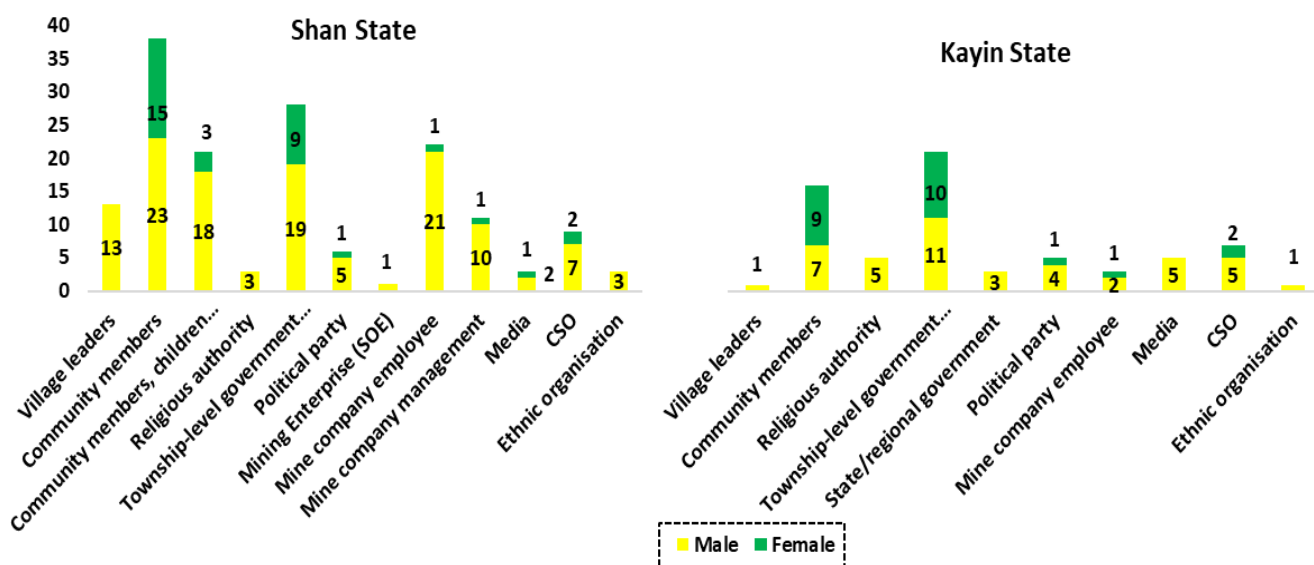

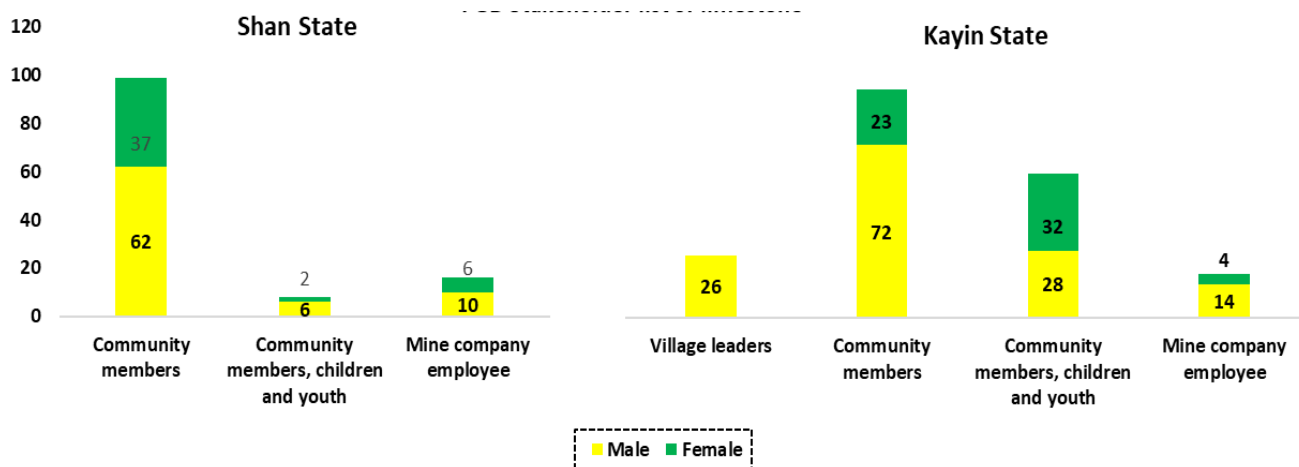


LIMESTONE

Focus Group Discussions

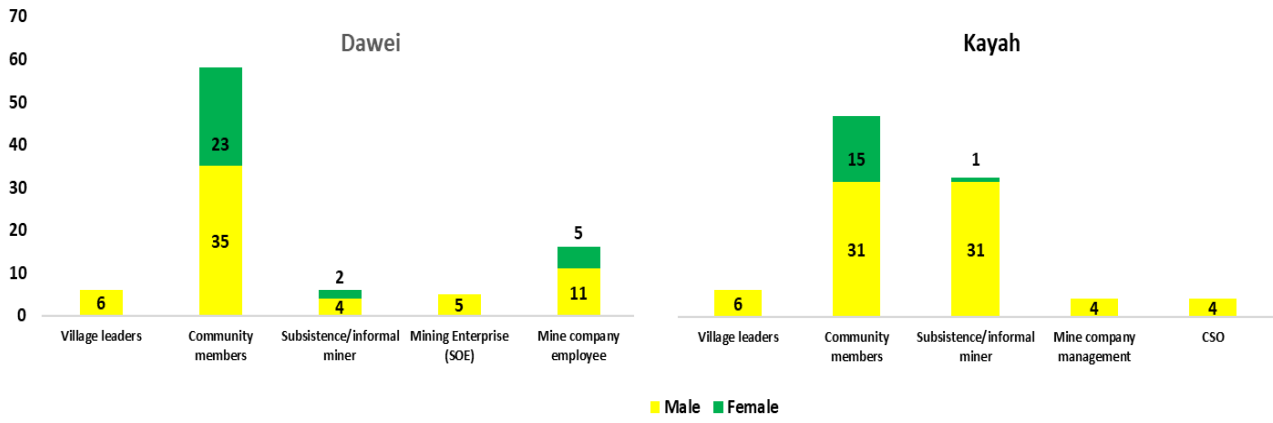
